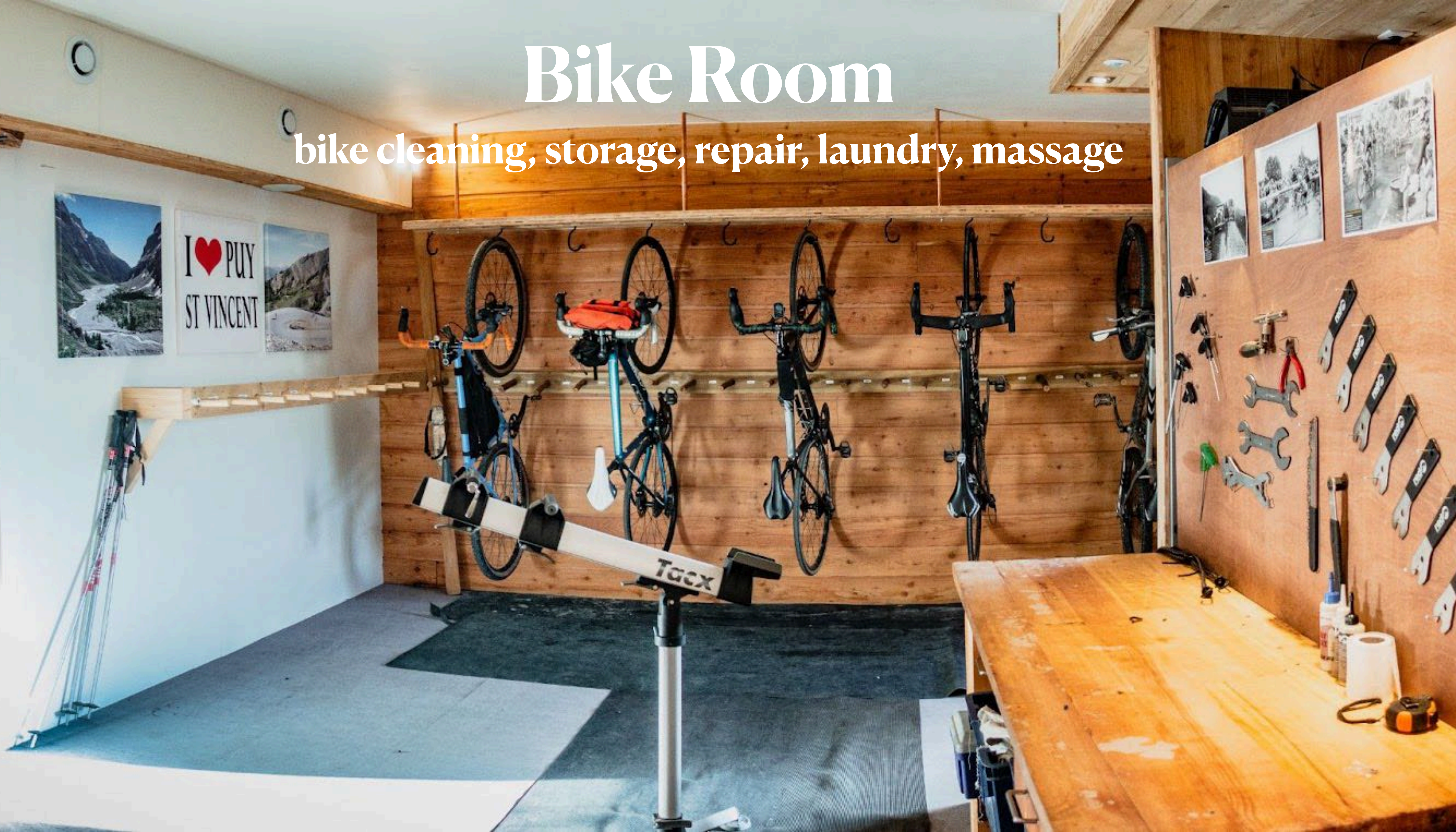
Bike-friendly hotel
